Dear Friends,

This week's bulletin is going to be a little different. I want to share with you a "state of the parish" – or Annual Report – in order to update you on how things are going here at St. Bernadette, especially as we continue to emerge from the challenge of COVID. My purpose here is to report on the financial performance of our parish for the last year as best as I can, as I begin my first year as your Pastor here.

A parish operates very much like a household; we have sources of income and we have expenses. In order to address these two items, we maintain a budget and that is monitored and reviewed by the Pastor as well as by our Finance Committee. We have contracted the services of Lochte & Company who manage our bookkeeping and accounting. Our bills are very similar to those of your household: we have gas & electric costs, water costs, maintenance, and insurance bills. Additionally, we have the salaries for our employees, with the associated benefits costs. There are also technology and administration costs that are not insignificant. Along with these, the hosts, wine, candles, incense, and other items that we use in our liturgies have their own costs. Day-to-day, I work with the Staff to try and minimize the costs that we can so that our expenses don't outstrip our income.

With the return to in-person worship and the loosening of space restrictions on our gatherings, we have experienced only a 5% decrease in or overall Offertory, which is not that bad – although our expenses will always remain and in some cases go up. I want to encourage you all to be attentive to your regular giving, but I also want to thank you for your great generosity in returning to supporting our parish!

As we participated in the Annual Appeal for Catholic Ministries for the Archdiocese, we are presently at 89% of our goal, with \$57,838 pledged to the campaign. Even in a pandemic, you are proving yourselves attentive to the

needs of the broader Church, and you should be proud of that. This generosity is also reflected in our continued capability to give to and support the many causes that we have adopted as a parish.

A few considerations that have helped us look ahead to a better year this year are that the monthly bill for the *Catholic Review* is being removed, and the new Annual Appeal will cover those costs. That's a savings to our budget of over \$11,000. We're also sharing some staffing costs with Christ the King as part of the pastorate process, which will reduce some of the costs of operation. However, as activity begins to increase, so will our costs, so please be as generous as you are able this year!

I want to end by expressing gratitude to Fr. Patrick Carrion for his wonderful and competent leadership over the past two years – especially navigating the challenge of COVID. He has left us in a great position and been a faithful steward of your generosity.

I am excited about entering into this new year with you all. While it is challenging to serve as a pastor of two large communities, it is also a blessing to encounter so many dedicated disciples. Know of my prayers for you each day, and I ask, in your charity, that you pray for me as well.
